Dear Tino and Marc:

Today the world is a little wilder thanks to your support. On behalf of my colleagues at Re:wild, thank you for your gift of \$2,426.15. Your support is a testament to our shared belief that protecting and restoring the wild is the most effective solution to the interconnected climate, biodiversity, and human well-being crises affecting our global community.

Re:wild launched in 2021, combining more than three decades of conservation impact of the Leonardo DiCaprio Foundation and Global Wildlife Conservation, leveraging expertise, partnerships, and platforms under one unified brand to bring new attention, energy, and voices together. Last year alone, Re:wild and partners helped conserve 231 million acres, maintaining more than 63 billion metric tons of carbon sequestration. We have several hundred active project sites in more than 80 countries where we are driving conservation action for 30,000 species.

We are encouraged by protection and rewilding success stories, such as one from Kenya, where Re:wild helped support the release of 64 individuals of Critically Endangered Hirola – the most threatened antelope species on Earth – from a sanctuary to supplement the free-ranging population in the Ishaqbini Community Conservancy lands. In Belize, together with international and local partners, we secured 30,000 acres of the Maya Forest Corridor – the first and most critical step toward protecting this important passageway for wildlife and preventing one of Mesoamerica's five great forests from being divided. And in Vietnam, Re:wild initiated a community-collaborative crime prevention project with partners in Pu Mat National Park to target the illegal wildlife trade of Vietnam's unique biodiversity - park staff already confirmed that thanks to additional resources, there is already an increase of nearly 20% in patrol coverage.

And now as we embark upon our goal to protect and restore other important places on Earth for biodiversity, climate, and people, we know that together we can make a difference. Thank you for joining the Re:wild movement. We are grateful for your tremendous role in transforming our shared home into a healthy, thriving one for all wildkind.
